MESSAGE FROM Chairman & Managing Director

Dear Readers,

I am proud to share this month's newsletter, reflecting NPCC's ongoing commitment to infrastructure excellence and inclusive national development.

We are proud to be executing the construction and development of Kendriya Vidyalaya at Washim, Maharashtra, as part of a broader initiative entrusted by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. This project includes academic blocks, residential quarters, sports facilities, and civic infrastructure—enhancing educational access and quality.

At the Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeosciences (BSIP), Lucknow, a new research facility is under development, blending Indo-Saracenic architectural elements with a design inspired by the Glossopteris leaf, symbolizing India's leadership in fossil research. The structure spans over 14,600 sq. m. and will house advanced laboratories to support scientific discovery.

In the healthcare domain, NPCC is leading the construction of a 160-bedded orthopedic unit at the Bone & Joint Hospital, Barzullah, Srinagar. Developed under the World Bank-financed Jhelum and Tawi Flood Disaster Recovery Project, it includes modular operation theatres, ICU wards, and advanced biomedical systems—ensuring resilient, high-quality care in the region.

On April 29, we marked the inauguration of the boys' hostel at Bal Vidya Mandir, Imphal, Manipur by Hon'ble MP Shri Maharaj Leishemba Sanajaoba. The hostel will serve over 3,000 tribal and economically disadvantaged students, promoting holistic education rooted in regional culture and Indian values.

Furthering our footprint in the North East, NPCC signed a MoU with the Department of Fisheries, Tripura, for the construction of a Fisheries Awareness cum Training Centre at Fatikroy, Unakoti. This facility will support sustainable aquaculture and livelihood enhancement.

Additionally, we formalized a partnership with the Central Council for Research in Yoga and Naturopathy (CCRYN) to construct two Central Research Institutes of Yoga & Naturopathy with 100-bedded hospitals at Raipur (Chhattisgarh) and Jatni (Odisha), advancing India's traditional wellness systems. These projects reflect our unwavering commitment to building resilient, inclusive infrastructure across sectors and regions. I thank our teams and stakeholders for their continued dedication.

Construction of New Building at Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeo science (BSIP), Lucknow, UP

The building is going to be a research institution which mainly comprises of research labs. The institute is one of its own kinds in India dealing with fossil research.

A new building at the Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeo sciences (BSIP) will have a blend of Indo-Saracenic styled architecture representing 'Lakhnavi tehzeeb' and design inspired from the Glossopteris leaf—the subject of the famed palaeobotanist's research.

The building comprises of B1+B2+G+6 steel & RCC composite framed structure with a total of 14640 sqm. Buildup Area.









PROJECT UPDATE:

Construction and design of Bone and Joint Hospital-Barzullah, Srinagar

The Design, Construction and AMC of 160 Bedded Specialized Orthopedic Units including Six Bedded ICU in Bone & Joint Hospital in Barzulla at Srinagar is one of the subproject identified and being constructed in World Bank financing under "Jhelum and Tawi Flood Disaster Recovery Project" (JTFDRP).
