

PROJECT UPDATE:

Inauguration of “Industrial Biotech Park at Kathua, Jammu” by Dr. Jitendra Singh, Hon’ble Union Minister of State for Science & Technology.

In an effort to boost the economic opportunities in Jammu and Kashmir, NPCC was awarded the responsibility for the construction of an Industrial Biotech Park at Ghatti, Kathua, Jammu by Indian Institute of Integrative Medicines (IIIM)- Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR).

With the construction works on the 6390 Sqm facility completed, Dr. Jitendra Singh, Hon’ble Union Minister of State for Science and Technology inaugurated the industrial park in Jammu. With immense opportunities opening up in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, the future of the region looks bright and promising.

PROJECT UPDATE:

Construction of Veterinary Dispensaries in under RIDF-24 and RIDF-25 in Karnataka

Department for Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Government of Karnataka, has entrusted the construction work of 312 units of Veterinary Dispensaries and Polyclinics in the state under RIDF Tranche – 24, Tranche-24 (Additional) and Tranche 25 scheme to NPCC.

1. Tranche 24 includes 4 nos. of polyclinic with typical built-up area of 834 sqm.
2. Tranche 24 (Additional) includes 127 Veterinary Dispensaries & Hospitals with typical built-up area of 138 sqm.
3. Tranche 25 includes 181 Veterinary Dispensaries, Hospitals & Polyclinics with typical built-up area ranging from 138 sqm to 834 sqm.
