



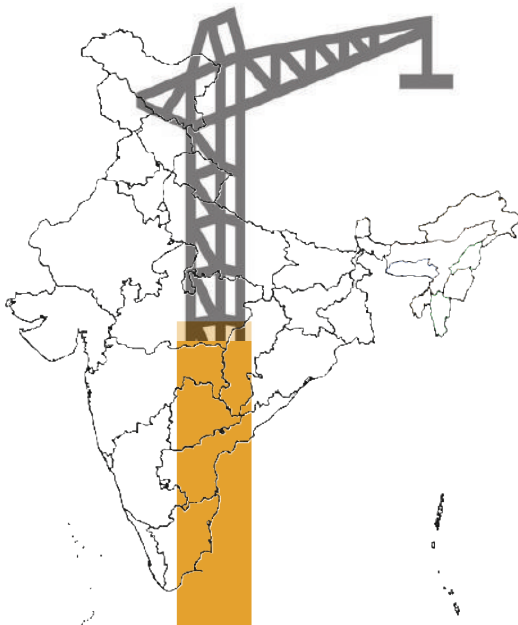

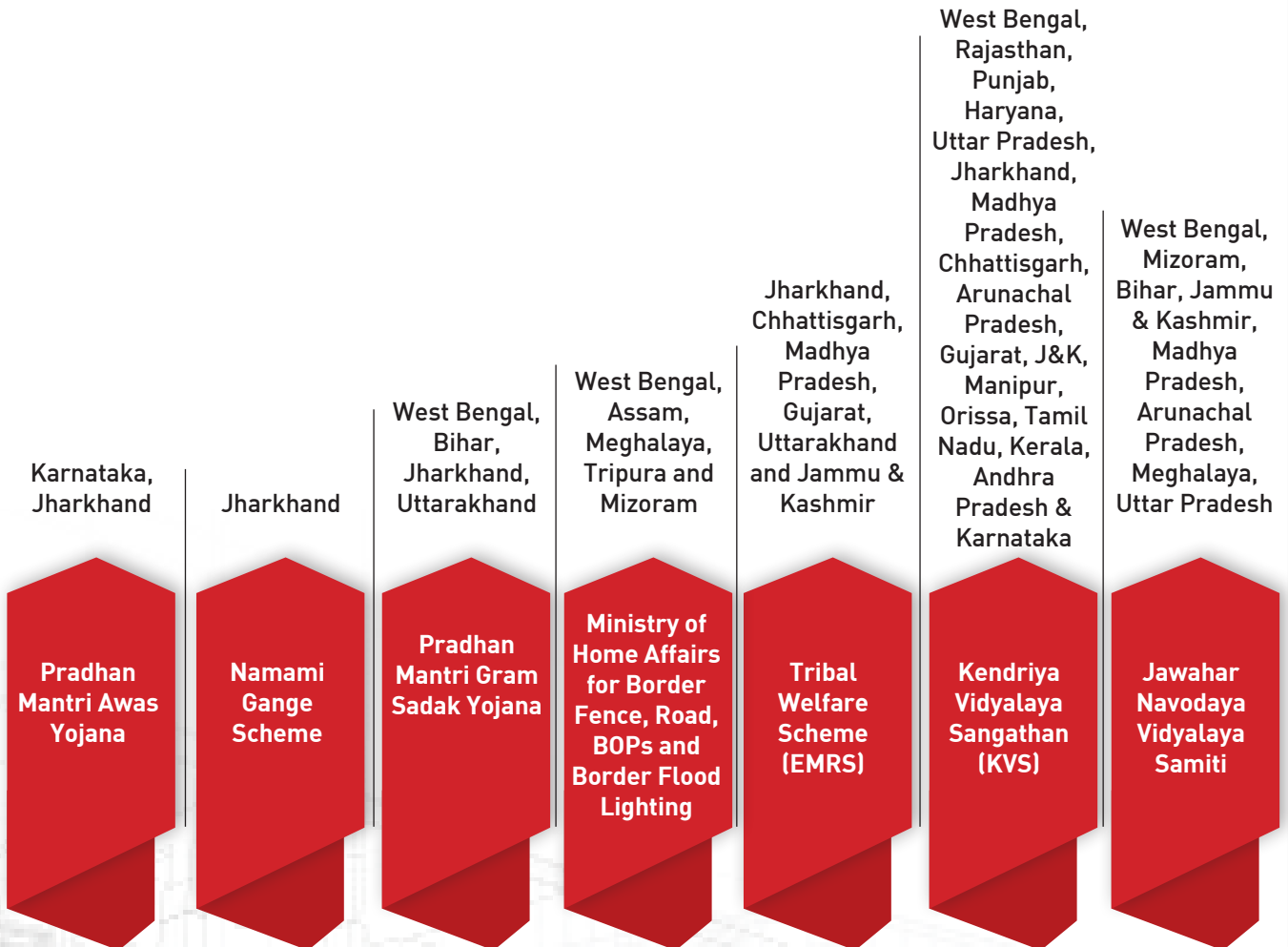

MESSAGE FROM Chairman & Managing Director

Dear Readers,

As the emerging economies across the globe continue to struggle with rising inflation, interest rates and the changing dynamics of geopolitics due to Russia-Ukraine war, India finds itself in a peculiar situation. Our economy is steadily recovering from the economic shock of 2020, when the GDP slumped to – 6.6% due to the restrictions induced in view of the Covid-19 outbreak. Today India's growth projections stand at 8% led by capital spending on large infrastructure projects by the Government.

Turning the pandemic into an opportunity for growth, our Government is focusing on expediting the implementation of infrastructure projects through the PM GatiShakti mission. As an important cog in the machinery of Jal Shakti Ministry, we at NPCC are committed to the vision of PM GatiShakti mission and would do our best to ensure proper implementation of plans and time-bound project completion. Our newsletter of this month highlights details of some of the road construction projects that we have undertaken under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana which is an important part of the GatiShakti mission. Providing connectivity for the easy movement of goods and citizens, NPCC has worked hard through the pandemic in building roads in rural Uttarakhand and West Bengal. Other projects highlighted in this newsletter include the Construction of Education Infrastructure in Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Meghalaya.

We will keep you abreast with all the latest news pertaining to NPCC through our newsletter in the future as well. I, personally, wish to thank my colleagues at NPCC who have been working tirelessly for the achievement of our objectives.

PROJECT UPDATE: Construction of Roads and Bridges under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, Uttarakhand

NPCC signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Authority, for the construction of Roads and Bridges in different parts of Uttarakhand under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana.

The total work for this project includes slope cutting works, slope protection works, preparation of sub-base, base and bitumen course, drainage works, construction of steel bridges (with necessary culverts and cross

drainage structures) and other ancillary works.

The works are being executed in remote areas of Pithoragarh, Almora, Champawat, Nainital, Chamoli, Pauri and Rudraprayag Districts.

When completed, these will provide connectivity, by way of an All-weather Road (with necessary culverts and cross drainage structures, which is operable throughout the year), to the eligible unconnected habitations in the rural as well as plain areas.

PROJECT UPDATE: Construction of Roads including 5 years Routine Maintenance Work under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, West Bengal

Based on an agreement signed between Ministry of Rural Development, West Bengal State Rural Development Authority (WBSRDA), and National Projects Construction Corporation Limited, NPCC has been awarded several road works under PMGSY (Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana) scheme in the blocks of Datan-I, Datan-II, Sankrail, Pingla, Mohanpur, Narayangarh, Sabang, Debra, Keshpur, Daspur-I, Daspur-II, Ghatal, Keshiary in the district of Paschim Medinipur and Gopiballavpur-I, Gopiballavpur-II, Jhargram, Jamboni, Sankrail, Nayagram, Binpur-I, Binpur-II in the district of Jhargram.

Earlier, NPCC had received 95 nos [471.274 Kms] and 114 nos [451.45 Kms] of packages in both the districts of Paschim Medinipur and Jhargram.

Again, 16 nos. [103.922 Kms] of packages of Batch-II, 67 nos. [188.27 Kms] of packages and 39 nos. [161.43 Kms] of packages of Batch-II and Batch-III respectively were allotted to NPCC.

Overall, NPCC has completed 95% of the project work since inception, till date.

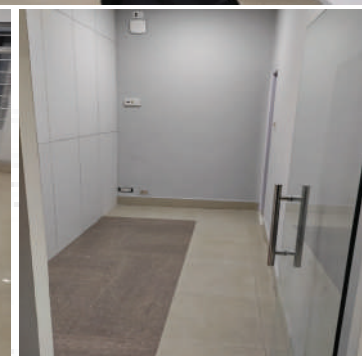
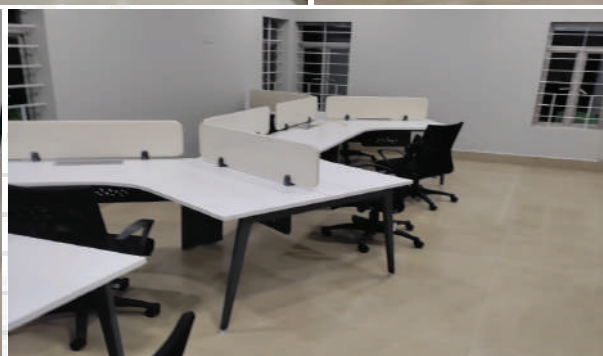
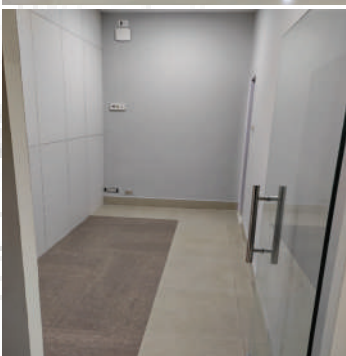
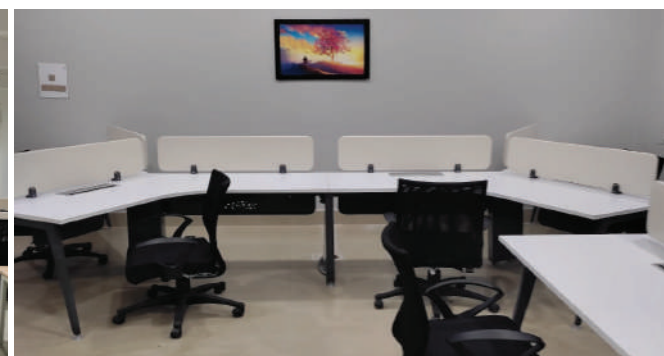


PROJECT UPDATE:

Construction of interior works for setting up the Center of Excellence + Start-up Innovation Zone (CoE+SIZ) in Software Technology Parks of India (STPI), Shillong

NPCC was awarded the contract for the Construction of a Centre of Excellence and Start-Up Innovation Zone at STPI in Shillong which has been established by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. NPCC undertook this task on a turnkey basis. Despite

the restrictions due to second and third COVID-19 waves in the country, all works have been completed as per deadlines and the project has been handed over to the client.





PROJECT UPDATE:

Construction of 2 Science Centres cum Planetariums at Baripada and Ghatagaon in Mayurbhanj and Keonjhar Districts, Odisha

NPCC has been assigned the Construction of two Science Centres cum Planetarium at Baripada and Ghatagaon in Odisha by the Science and Technology Department, Government of Odisha. Construction for both projects is scheduled to be completed in 15 months. The science center is a demonstration building aimed at promoting and popularizing science, research, technology, innovation and leading through experiments and showcasing the achievements of science, economy, and culture and create an interactive planetarium to enhance the educational knowledge on science, solar system and universe as a whole.

As of date 65% of the works have been completed.

The Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD), Sriperumbudur, Tamil Nadu, an Institution of National Importance by the Act of Parliament No. 35/2012 under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India has entrusted NPCC the work of Construction of various buildings and external Development works.

The project includes the construction of Class Room Block, Boys' Hostel, Girls' Hostel, Type IV Residence (3 BHK) and Type III Residence (2 BHK) and allied external development works.

The work is scheduled to be completed by the end of May, 2022.

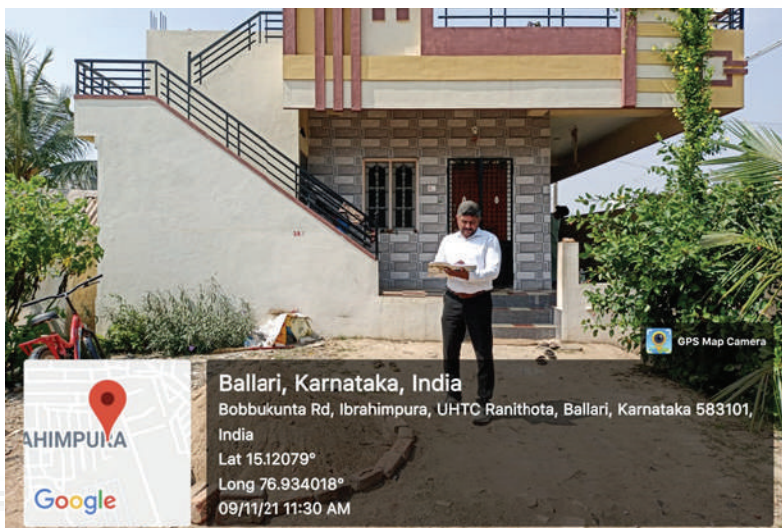
